This month we helped people in the Provinces of

Bedfordshire, Devonshire, South & East Caribbean, Bombay, Cornwall, Essex, London, West Yorkshire, Leicestershire & Rutland, Monmouthshire, North & East Yorkshire, East Lancashire, Cheshire, Northumberland and Surrey.

We gave help in a number of different ways:

- Help with repairs of a utility building to a Brother residing in a care home. His wife was hardly managing in cold and damp conditions.
- A Brother too ill to complete much needed renovations to his home after a heart attack.
- A Brother living abroad for help with medication for his wife.
- A Brother who desperately needed boiler repairs before the cold weather set in.
- Repairs to a Brothers shower unit that had been broken for 6 months.

At these meetings we received 23 new applications for relief. 6 were resubmissions after information received and only 3 applications were deferred. 2 applications were declined a grant.

Grants were made to 24 Petitioners and the total amount awarded was

£52,797
